She discussed how fiscal and monetary structures shape gender outcomes, stressing that economic policies are never gender-neutral. Key issues included the invisibilization of women's unpaid labour, gaps in gender budgeting, and persistent inequalities in nutrition, healthcare, and social security—exacerbated by the removal of



						nutrition questions from official surveys. Dr. Dewan also highlighted falling female labour force participation, barriers to credit, informal work vulnerabilities, and gendered taxation

Using human development maps, he highlighted how Himalayan states outperform much of India in literacy, health, and per capita income due to equitable social structures and better access to resources. He contrasted this with the stagnation in states like Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, and Rajasthan, where entrenched elites and unequal land ownership hinder



						progress. Discussing the Northeast and Himachal Pradesh, he emphasized how social structures, corruption levels, and poor-quality public services shape outcomes. He concluded by urging quality-driven reforms in industry, education, and infrastructure.

The panel examined gaps between policy intent and implementation across sectors. Mr. V. R. Raman highlighted inadequate social spending, weak local governance, and the need for equitable financing. Dr. Surajit Mazumdar discussed India's premature de-



						industrialisation, labour surplus, and the mismatch between GDP and employment shares. Dr. Indrani Gupta stressed market failures in healthcare and the urgent need for Universal Health Care. Dr. Reetika Khera critiqued biometric authentication in PDS for excluding vulnerable groups. Ms. Anindita Mukherjee addressed WASH challenges and sustainable urbanisation. The session encouraged students to critically examine policy realities.
