- Photography Contest (2nd September 2024): A contest on the theme 'Freedom in her Frame' was held where students submitted their best photographs. Three winners were chosen and mentioned in the instagram post.
- Heritage walk (18th October 2024): A heritage walk to Mirza Ghalib ki Haveli along with Silsila Heritage.
- Book Bazaar (23rd October 2024): A sale of used/second-hand books at extremely low prices. The Book Bazaar saw huge participation both in the donation and buying of books.
- Freshers (24th October 2024): A celebration of the first years through performances and fun activities.
- Movie Screening (6th March 2025): The movie horror/fantasy 'Tumbbad' was screened to

- Photography competition (30th March 2025): On the theme of 'Translating Cultures: Perspectives and Possibilities', this competition was open to all the students across departments of MH. Through this theme participants were encouraged to explore the dynamic intersections of cultures, traditions and identities of India. They were also motivated to explore and highlight the unique traditions, struggles and lived experiences of the marginalised communities.
- Collage-making competition (1st April 2025): Themed 'Language of Art: Translating Emotions Across Cultures', this competition explored how art transcends all language barriers and conveys universal human emotions. The submissions were required to feature different artistic expressions from various cultures.
- Litfest, The Annual Fest of the Department of English (2nd April 2025): The theme for the year was 'Translating Cultures: Perspectives and Possibilities'. The joyous day was accompanied by multiple contests like photography and collage making along with the final round of paper presentation competition. An on-the-spot creative story telling competition was also conducted with the selected participants from the quiz. The annual tradition of organising a Book Bazaar was also followed. The eventful day ended with a flash mob and a live music performance.
- Litfest Academic Paper Presentation (2nd April 2025): The final round of paper presentations was held with 16 selected participants.
- Litfest Fiction Forge (2nd April 2025): A creative story writing and presentation competition was held in two rounds; first was a qualifying quiz on Unstop and the 7 selected groups and 3 solo participants battled the final round at SAC. This competition was open to all students of DU.
- Litfest Book Bazaar (2nd April 2025): The English Department's own book fair or popularly called as 'Daryaganj of MH' was conducted. The book bazaar is an annual fair of books where donated books are resold at the cheapest price, such that one book can be read by more than one person and especially students get access to affordable reads.
- Farewell (24th April 2025): The juniors, faculty members and the newly elected student body bid the graduating batch a warm farewell by congratulating on their new journeys ahead. An informal session was commemorated by cutting of cake and cherishing the moments shared in these 3 years in college.
