REMOTE SENSING WITH QGIS

The workshop took us from mountain tops to satellites, equipping us all in a wonderful journey at the end of which we all gained something new to take back with us into the virtual world of remote sensing.

01. Introduction
Remote sensing is the collection and interpretation of information about an object without being in physical contact with the object, through platforms like aircrafts and satellites. It is commonly restricted to methods that employ electromagnetic energy such as light, radio, sound etc. In the means of detecting and measuring target characteristics.

- To understand remote sensing and its applications.
- To process the image digitally through QGIS.
- To calculate and interpret NDVI for Himachal Pradesh.

05. Interpretation
The report has north and south part of the region shows barren land or low vegetation corresponding to the physiography of Himachal Pradesh which is covered by glaciers in the north, and accordingly the north and south western part of the region shows a high degree of vegetation. As a result from the graphs below, the percentage of bare soil or water has been decreasing throughout the decades while that of vegetation has been increasing. This can be attributed to climate change which has resulted in an increase in the average temperature.

06. Conclusion
In the report, the NDVI data for the consecutive decades were represented with the help of tables and bar diagrams which can help us in identifying the vegetative cover of Himachal Pradesh and its transformation over the decades.
