Seminars/conferences/workshops conducted by the Department



1. On 6th August 2022, Department of Mathematics, Miranda House, organized an online doubt clearing session with Ms. Shruti Goyal on internships and placements. Having served as the President of Placement Cell of Miranda House (2021-22) she briefed the students on the resume format to be followed, the procedure of placements on campus and guided them on exploring various internship roles.



2. On 20th September, Pankaj Singh, a research scientist and Image Informatics lead at the Texas A&M Health Science Centre was invited as a speaker on "Introduction to Data Science and its Application using Python." He provided students with a fundamental understanding of Data Science while also providing them practical understanding of Python Libraries. He closed the seminar by encouraging young people to delve into the field of Data Science.



3. Paving way for more academic endeavors, in collaboration with IQAC, Miranda House. Mathematics Department of conducted informative lecture on "Fundamentals of Real Assistant Analysis". Dr. Н. Ananthnarayan, Professor, Department of Mathematics, IIT Bombay led the students from basics of analysis to a peak of sequences and series. He advised students on the opportunities in research and academics after graduation.





4. On collaboration 13th January, in IQAC-Miranda House, esteemed alumni of the Department, Ms. Jasika Singh, who worked as the Deputy Head was invited to host a talk on "Insurance Analytics and Fraud Detection". She gave the audience an insight into the world of an actuary, the key skill sets required to become an actuary, the roles to play if one enters this field, and an overview of how to prepare for the exams. She expounded on the importance of patience and dedication in becoming a great actuary.




5. The Department **Mathematics** IOAC-Miranda House collaboration with organized a seminar on "Bureaucracy in India" with the esteemed Indian Audit and Accounts Service officer, Dr. Shourjo Chaterjee on 18th January 2023. He impressed that the aim of the session was to discuss what it entails to be a bureaucrat and what an enthusiast can expect from the profession in the future. The session focused on the Civil Services mainly Examination and the functioning of different officials of the Civil Services while explaining how bureaucracy functioned alongside the Government of India.





6. The Department of Mathematics, Miranda House, in collaboration with IQAC, organized a two-day Capacity Building Workshop on Mathematica, a software widely used in various fields of research and academia, on May 22 and 23, 2023, with Mr. Brij Mohan as the speaker. The workshop was organized for the first-year students to familiarize them with Mathematica and coding.

On 15th June, 2023, Sankhya, the Society of Department of Mathematics, Miranda House in collaboration with Miranda House-IQAC, organized a seven day workshop, 'Mathematical Data Science Workshop' led by Dr. Niteesh Sahni, Associate Professor, Department of Mathematics, Shiv Nadar University. The workshop did an in-depth mathematical treatment of the various topics in addition to the demonstration of the various methods on real world data sets. No prior knowledge of programming was assumed. The mathematics involved will include mainly Linear algebra, Vector calculus, Probability and Statistics.


## **Extension Activities organized**
