## THE ACADEMIC YEAR IN RETROSPECT

ALL THAT WE LEARNED AND UNLEARNED




We kick-started the academic year with a seminar on 14th August, 2018. The discussion was on “**Why Surrogates do not want a ban on surrogacy**” by Prof. Tulsi Patel, a former professor at the School of Economics, which was mainly focused on the dynamism between the institution of marriage and reproduction respectively and how, with the introduction of contraception techniques, the dynamics of their relationship have changed. The ‘commercialisation and commodification’ of the institution of surrogacy formed a major part of the discussion. Among the various perspectives and views on the issue of surrogacy, Prof. Patel engaged with the most dominant view- that of the feminists and primarily that of the importance of choice. She also threw light on the poor financial conditions of the surrogate mothers which render them blind to many malpractices which are an inherent part of the institution of surrogacy. They want a ban on surrogacy because they perceive it as a way out of their penury for paying off debts, running the household, etc. She concluded by saying that surrogacy stands on the basis of economic necessity and is not a product of modernity.

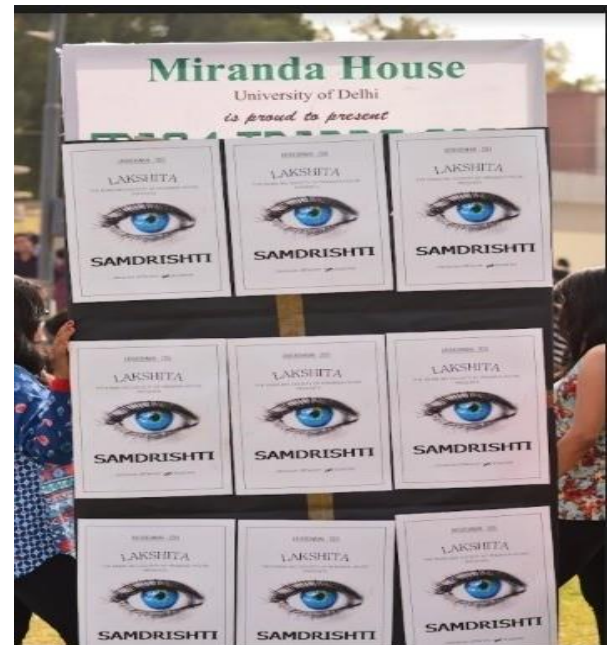

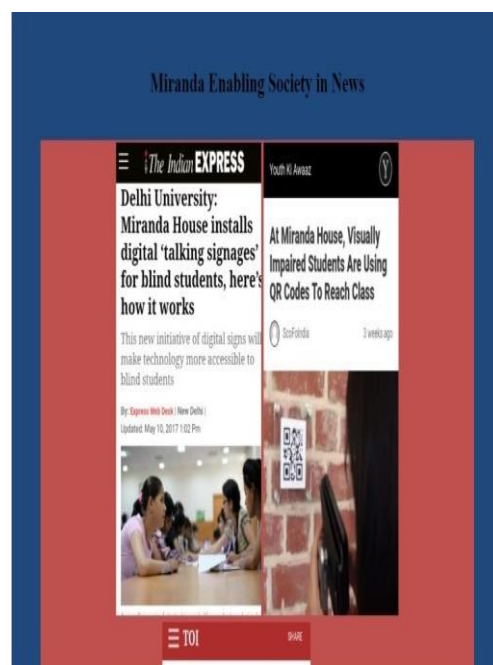


