


Part B.1

Seminars/conferences/workshops conducted by the Department

DBT- Star sponsored workshop on Understanding our **Environment:** Human Interference conducted Department of Zoology under the aegis of D. S. Kothari Centre for Research and Innovation in Science Education (DSKC), Miranda House on August 18, 2017. The workshop was well attended by over forty students across various disciplines and universities in and around Delhi. This workshop aimed to introduce and motivate students about the stressed environment and how interaction among different organisms of various strata impact human health. The focus of the workshop students was on developing an understanding of the contemporary research on xenobiotic degradation and how they can contribute to Swachh and Swasth Bharat Abhiyan. The programme was coordinated by Dr. Rekha Kumari and Dr. Simran Jit from the Department. Participants-40.



FIELD VISIT TO ASOLA BHATTI WILDLIFE SANCTUARY








Part B.3


The Department hosted the **Fresher's Party** for the incoming batch on 23th August of 2017-18 at room no-248. The event saw huge participation. There were 92 students.
