

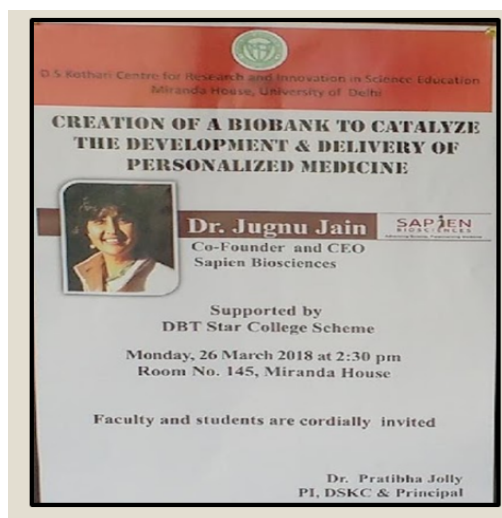

The Department hosted the **Fresher's Party** for the incoming batch on 23th August of 2017-18 at room no-248. The event saw huge participation. There were 92 students.

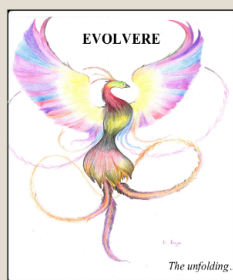

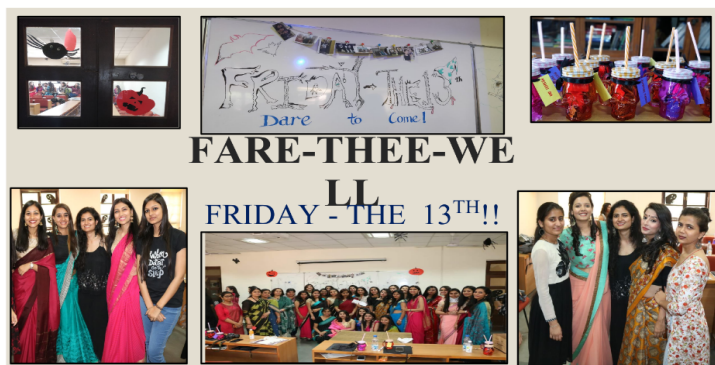
LAUNCH OF THE DEPARTMENT MAGAZINE AND T-SHIRTS
