My short term plans focus on researching on health issues in Punjab, specifically on the issue of rising incidents of cancer in the Malwa region including districts in Bhatinda and Mansa. The cost of cancer treatment is a significant financial strain on families, especially in rural areas where incomes are generally lower. There have been reports of "cancer trains" where patients travel from Punjab to Rajasthan to seek affordable treatment. There is growing advocacy for stricter regulations on pesticide use, improved water quality monitoring, and more robust public health interventions to address the cancer crisis.
