- Geetanjali came second in the choir competition Lashkara 2018 at Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Khalsa College.




• The team won the 3rd prize in Udaan Utsav (youth festival in Hansraj College), Hindu College and Sri Ram College of Commerce.
