Events/Seminars/conferences/workshops/Extension Activities organized

The annual orientation of the Enabling Unit was organised on 13th August, under the guidance of Dr. Chanda Sagar, the convener and the committee members Dr. Malti Sharma, Ms Mhadeno Jungi, Dr. Surabhi, Mr. Kundan, the resource person, NSS volunteers and the Union. The Principal was presented with a handmade card by the Students Union before her address, in which she talked about the views and problems of accessibility in the college and assured to take care of everything. A general introduction of the first years was followed by a discussion on short term solutions. The session was extremely helpful for the first-year students.

The HTBF Scholarship Interview Session 2019: The Help the Blind Foundation provides scholarships for the visually impaired students pursuing higher education, for which they sent their volunteers for taking interviews and verifying the documents on 29th August, 2019. The event was a success due to the efforts of the HTBF volunteers Mr. D.K. Sharma, Mr. Bharadwaj and Mr. Nandkishor, committee members, especially Dr. Malti Sharma, NSS volunteers and the society members. The Principal also graced the occasion towards the end. Blindfold walk-An awareness drive: The enabling units of numerous DU colleges came together on the annual fortnight of Eye Donation Drive to participate in a rally organised by Mr. Lalit Kumar, Saksham on 3rd September, 2019. The sighted students comprising NSS volunteers and EOC volunteers were blindfolded and they walked behind the visually impaired students, to understand and experience the problems faced by the blind people in our society. Everyone was encouraged to sign up for the posthumous eye donation.

Hindi Diwas Inter College Competition: The event, held on 14th September, 2020, began with lighting of the lamp by our honourable Principal and esteemed guests followed by Saraswati Vandana. The first competition for the day was a debate on the topic “One Nation- One Election”, for which the judges were Mrs. Jaya and Mr. Israel. The winners were: 1st - Pushpa and Nishita, 2 nd - Umesh and Sandeep and 3 rd - Shimpi and Moni. The second competition was the Self- Composed Poetry Competition, where all the participants presented their beautiful muses. The judges were Mr. Pritam and Mr. Ashutosh. Reading Competition was also organised in the ADRC lab, with the judges being Mr. Harish Gulati and Mr. Pushkar. The winners for the same were: 1st - Mansi Tyagi, 2nd - Nishita and 3rd - Rishabh Dube. The winners were awarded with cash prizes and certificates.

Inauguration of HTBF EMET Project: The Help the Blind Foundation, Samarathanam and the Cognizant Foundation came together for a computer training workshop for the students.

The inauguration ceremony was held on September 19, 2019. It began with Saraswati Vandana followed by address of the Convener and the Principal. The project was introduced by Mr. Bharadwaj and Shivaji Sir from HTBF. Ms. Anupriya gave all the vital details and descriptions of the training. The trainees were introduced to the lab and the schedule for the classes was decided.

Movie Screening by Saksham: The movie “Lage Raho Munna Bhai” was screened for visually impaired students by the the Saksham trust on 2nd November, 2019 in the auditorium of the National Museum, near India Gate. Dr. Chanda Sagar, Dr. Malti Sharma, Dr. Surabhi, Mr. Naresh and some NSS volunteers who accompanied the students for the screening. This was a beautiful experience for all the members of the society.

Mobility workshop: The mobility and road safety workshops were conducted by the National Association for Blind, Delhi on 19th February, 2020 in the college premises. Mr. Anil, Mr. Abhishek and Ms. Nikita joined us from NAB for the training in which 18 students along with Dr. Chanda Sagar, the convener participated. The students learned about various practical techniques to protect themselves while navigating using a cane and useful apps that assist in the same. Every participant was provided with a mobility kit after the workshop and three students: Poonam Singla, Rinky and Soni were felicitated with prizes.

Self-defence training: A self-defence workshop was conducted in collaboration with the American India Foundation from 2nd to 6th March, 2020 between 2:00pm to 5:00pm each day under the guidance of Mr. Arvind Khaire, the master trainer for the event. The students and Dr. Chanda Sagar, our convener, enthusiastically participated in the training. We received assistance from the NSS volunteers for the same. The workshop covered many theoretical and practical aspects of self-defence including training in techniques of palm-heel strike, free kick, hair pulling, etc. along with lectures and case-studies on women safety apps and recent cases of molestation and rape.

Webinar on challenges during lockdown: A webinar was organised on May 16, 2020 on the topic “Challenges faced by the differently-abled during the COVID-19 lockdown and possible measures”. The illustrious speakers for the day were Dr. Anita Ghai, Professor in School of Human Studies, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University and Dr. Kaushal Kant Mishra, COVID-19 specialist in Primus Super Speciality Hospital, Delhi. The two-hour webinar began at 11:00am and saw the presence of the Principal, the convener and a total of 70 participants. The webinar was a very insightful and enriching experience for all. Sandeep sir provided his invaluable support in handling the technical aspects of the event.

International Yoga Day webinar & Competitions: A two-day event was organized on the occasion of International Yoga Day/ Youth Day/ Music Day. On the first day, 21st June, we had a two-hour webinar on “Role of Yoga in the all-round development of the Youth” with Mr. Kasinaadh Lakkaraju, Vice-president of Saksham and Dr. Navdeep Joshi, Founder of Navyoga gram as the guest speakers. On the second day, 22nd June, we had a live music competition, judged by Dr. Shalini Thakur and Dr. Namrata Deb ‘Disha’, and a creative-writing competition judged by Dr. Rajni Disodia and Dr. Pramod Kumar Mehra which saw active participation of students.
