In 2025, we proudly hosted Inspire India, a panel discussion highlighting the vital link between enterprise and entrepreneurship, featuring distinguished speakers like Harshita Singh(Consultant at the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports), Priya Gupta(Senior Assistant Director of International Affairs at FICCI), Chinuu Kwatra (Founder of Khushiyaan Foundation), Prof. Major General Dr Dilawar Singh (Co-President of Global Development Bank).

Currently we have 5 ongoing projects:

Project Nitara - Replacing styrofoam and bubble wrap with packaging made out of mycelium and agricultural stubble

- Ideas to Impact (i2I) – IIT Madras | Supported by Wipro Foundation Project Nitara was selected among the **Top 10 teams** at the national level in Ideas to Impact (i2I), a nation-wide sustainability and circular economy innovation competition. The team received **₹1 lakh in prize money**, along with mentorship and research opportunities at IIT Madras, and qualified for the Carbon Zero Challenge (CZC).
- Design for Bharat – Viksit Bharat Young Leaders Dialogue (2025)
The competition followed a state-to-national selection process focused on youth-led innovation for Viksit Bharat @2047. Nitara **won the state-level championship**, earning the opportunity to **represent Delhi at the national level**.

Project Dharang - Pioneered around stopping the use of single use plastic through our tote bags, we now begin to take more technologically advanced steps in reducing textile waste

Project Ikhtiyaar - Turning coffee waste into eco friendly coffee coal and clay products reducing landfill burden, greenhouse gas emissions and preventing cancer causing genetic mutation

Project Riwayat- Launched in 2025, it focuses on using discarded fabric waste and turning them into durable, lightweight, and eco-friendly bricks. These bricks reduce landfill pressure, offer thermal insulation, and support green construction.
