Overview of the Society

The English Debating Society of Miranda House is a group of individuals who are eager to learn, read, and grow in various spheres of life. We make an effort to practice the art of debating by concentrating on three crucial areas: manner, content, and procedure. Additionally, we encourage members to gain as much experience as possible, and we do our best to respect and accommodate the various identities that make up our society.

Activities

The **Annual Council Elections** were held with the freshers inducted to form a band of the faces that were to take on the brunt of organizational work and spearhead training and logistics of the Society. Nominations were followed by the manifesto reading, and post that elections took place on the 28th of April, 2022

Inaayat was a one-of-a-kind fundraiser debate, organized in collaboration with Q.E.D. The English Debating Society of Gargi College, in order to extend tangible support to women and children in need, as part of our shared responsibility as NCM societies in the circuit. The tournament was conducted in the Asian Parliamentary Format, across three days i.e., 11th to 13thNovember, 2022. It was an offline tournament with the five in-rounds conducted in Miranda House college and the out-rounds held in Gargi college.

All proceeds from the tournament including the entirety of registration fees and money raised from sponsorships that was in excess of what we needed to break even on the organizing costs of

the tournament, was donated to **Prerna: Social Development and Welfare Society,** a non-profit, non-political and non-government organization registered under the societies Registration Act XXI of 1860, which is actively engaged in social services with a focus on the upliftment of the underprivileged. A total of Rs. 61,500/- was donated to the foundation after the successful conclusion of the tournament.Inaayat PD 2022 saw participation from various colleges and was indeed a huge success. More significantly, the tournament did not just provide an able platform for debaters and judges to compete but it also contributed in the fulfillment of our commitment towards the social upliftment and empowerment of women.

Auditions for the term were held in full fervor, with almost 300 applicants across courses going through rounds of rigorous selections. The first round was in the turncoat debate format where speakers were given impromptu topics to support and defend within the same speech. This was followed by an interview round where speakers were met with questions to gauge debate aptitude as well as the time they would be able to allot to the activity. With well-rounded insight in hand, we were able to band together a group of the top 32 applicants as valuable additions to debsoc to be trained into vivid, opinionated debaters of Miranda House DebSoc.

Debsoc held its **annual British Parliamentary Tournament, Manzar 2023**, through the online forum of Zoom+Discord on 25-26th March, 2023. It saw participation from Institutions not only across the country but across the globe, which made it a one of a kind experience for participating debaters to gain exposure to ideas from debating circuits outside their own. The tournament saw invigorating debates on topics ranging across various themes, such as economics, politics, philosophy and others.

Manzar 2023 hosted over 400 individuals, making it not only Miranda House's biggest parliamentary tournament till date, but also one of India's grandest tournaments in this season. It not only received enthusiastic participation from across the country, but also had participants from countries like Pakistan, Bangladesh, South Africa, Malaysia, Russia, Philippines, Indonesia, Britain and the United States.
