3. Exhibition Debate- The society conducted an Exhibition Debate, open to all students of the college, on 17th September 2024 in the Student Activity Area. The debate was held in the Asian Parliamentary format to introduce students to Collegiate Parliamentary Debating.



4. Regular Mock Debates: The society conducted daily mock debates covering a wide array of topics, including politics, philosophy, technology, and culture. These debates were held both online and offline, offering members the flexibility to participate according to their schedules and preferences. They served as a platform for members to voice their opinions, engage in constructive dialogue, and refine their oratory skills. In addition to intra-college mock debates, members also participated in inter-college mock debates, both in person and through online platforms, aimed at bolstering confidence and removing hesitation among participants.

5. Intercollegiate Competitions: Members of the English Debating Society participated in several intercollegiate debating competitions, showcasing the talent and prowess of our members. We secured commendable positions in prestigious competitions, earning recognition for our dedication and skill.

6. Workshops and Training Sessions: To enhance the debating skills of our members, the society conducted workshops and training sessions on argumentation, rebuttal, and public speaking. Experienced debaters were invited to share their insights and provide valuable guidance to our members.

7. Shama Kohli- Shama Kohli is our annual conventional debate tournament. It was





8. Over 250 participants from various colleges and universities nationwide joined in the competition. The debates covered a wide array of topics, from international relations to economics, fostering healthy competition among the participants.
