Overview

Throughout the academic year 2023-24, MH Vatavaran, the environmental society of Miranda House, embarked on a remarkable journey of raising environmental awareness and instilling a sense of responsibility among students. The society conducted numerous events, competitions, workshops, and campaigns to promote environmental awareness and climate action, leaving an indelible mark on our campus. MH Vatavaran successfully participated in various Swachh Bharat activities throughout the year, such as Swachhta hi Seva, Swachhta Pakhwada, and Swachhta Shramdaan. Under the leadership of our Principal, Prof. Bijayalaxmi Nanda, students, and faculty participated in the "Ek Tareek Ek Ghanta" Swachhta hi Seva campaign on 1st October 2023. MH Vatavaran also organized several cleanliness drives within the campus and adopted villages of the college, including, the Clean Your Campus Drive, in North Campus, University of Delhi. Volunteers participated in the drive and removed all paper waste used during student election campaigning, which was then recycled at the Paper Recycling Plant of Miranda House. Plantation drives were regularly organized in collaboration with various organizations to create a bigger and more meaningful impact. These drives included partnerships with the Garden Committee of Miranda House, the Department of Chemistry, and the Mission for Life Campaign (Govt. of India), as well as a part of the World Environment Day celebrations.















MH *Vatavaran* received several accolades for its environmental activities during the academic year. The society successfully participated and completed the **Apex District ECO-SDG Championship 2023** and received an **outstanding performance grade** of "S" for North Campus in October 2023. Additionally, MH *Vatavaran* was acknowledged for its participation in **Global Roti Day** organized under the **Poshan Abhiyan Scheme**, **Govt. of India**. In continuing efforts to reduce the use of single-use plastics, MH *Vatavaran* signed an **MoU with Bisleri** under the **Bottles for Change CSR Initiative**. Faculty advisors of the society also attended various workshops and conferences related to climate change and sustainability, including **U75: Net Zero Regional Workshop for Universities/HEIs organized by the University of Delhi and Green Teri Foundation**, and the **Delhi Youth for Climate Summit** organized by NCT Delhi and EPIC India. As in previous years, MH *Vatavaran* continued its collaboration with WWF India on various



environmental campaigns, including the **ECHO-2023 Challenge**, an exciting PAN-India volunteering program to ideate, design, develop, and implement conservation projects.

















Monthly Activities

The academic session was officially inaugurated with an **Oath-Taking Ceremony held on June 2, 2024**. This event marked the beginning of a foundational commitment among new members. The ceremony was led by Prof. (Dr.) Chirashree Ghosh from the Department of Environmental Studies, University of Delhi.








On June 5, 2024, volunteers from MH *Vatavaran* engaged in collaborative events with **WWF**, **India** and **IIT**, **Delhi** to commemorate **World Environment Day**. These joint activities were designed to enhance awareness of critical environmental issues. Subsequently, on June 27, 2024, MH *Vatavaran* hosted the **Tide Turners Plastic Challenge Orientation Session**. This event was dedicated to mobilizing efforts and strategies to combat plastic pollution

In July 2024, MH *Vatavaran* engaged in several impactful initiatives. On July 4, a **Plantation Drive** was conducted which aimed at enhancing campus greenery and highlighting the importance of afforestation. Following this, on July 11, the **Polythene Bag Biography Challenge** provided members with a creative platform to explore and address the environmental impacts of polythene bags. Later in the month, on July 28, MH *Vatavaran* conducted a **Cleanliness Drive**, reinforcing our commitment to maintaining a pristine environment. This event was complemented by a **Quiz on World Nature Conservation Day**, which aimed to broaden participants' understanding of



conservation issues. Additionally, our active representation at the G20 @ India: Making India Count event on July 30 demonstrated our dedication to global sustainability discussions.





The month of August saw a diverse range of activities. On August 5, the **Green Steps Challenge** encouraged members to adopt sustainable practices in their daily lives. A **Photography Contest** held on August 9 provided a platform to celebrate and capture the beauty of nature. The **Eco-Product Sales Drive**, which took place on August 16 and again on August 23-24, promoted sustainable consumption by offering eco-friendly products. Furthermore, the **Eco-Color: Transforming Tomorrow** event on August 23 integrated art with sustainability, inspiring participants to envision a more sustainable future.

In September, MH *Vatavaran* highlighted **World Bamboo Day** on the 18th with a blog that underscored the role of bamboo in sustainable development. Additionally, another **Campus Cleanliness Drive** was conducted on September 15, further reinforcing our commitment to environmental cleanliness. Throughout the month, various blogs and events focused on



environmental awareness, including a blog on World Rhino Day and continued efforts in campus cleanliness.





October 2024 was a month of notable activities for MH *Vatavaran*, beginning with the celebration of **World Animal Day** on October 4 with a blog post published to raise awareness about animal rights and biodiversity. The month also saw a significant community-focused initiatives- with the **Mega Cleanup Drive** held on October 8. This event extended beyond our campus and involved local community participation in environmental cleanup efforts. On October 10, the **Freshers Talent Search**, an event designed to welcome new members and showcase their talents was held. Following this, the **DIY Fashion Contest** on October 22 provided a platform for participants to creatively use recycled materials, highlighting the intersection of sustainability and style.





In November, MH *Vatavaran* had the privilege of hosting the **Shri Jagdeep Dhankar**, **Vice President of India** on November 2nd. During his visit, the Vice President acknowledged the scoeity's ongoing efforts and offered valuable insights into our initiatives. The following day, November 3rd, we engaged the community with a **Nukkad Natak**, a series of street performances designed to address and raise awareness about environmental issues. On November 7th, the **Bottles for Change Event** was held, focusing on the recycling of plastic bottles and promoting the principles of a circular economy. Later in the month, on November 22nd, we organized an **Air Pollution and Health Event**, which aimed to educate participants about the impacts of air pollution on health.








In December, MH *Vatavaran* hosted a **Stall at the Alumnae Meet** on December 2nd, where we had the opportunity to showcase our work and initiatives to former *Mirandians*. On December 9th, a series of blogs were published, covering significant environmental topics such as World Soil Day and International Cheetah Day, which underscored the importance of these issues. On the same day, the **Green Guru Gathering Interviews** offered a platform for environmental experts to share their knowledge and experiences with our members.





The academic session continued into January and February with various activities. On January 11th, we collaborated with **Viksit Bharat** @ **2047**, and on January 30th, we organized a Poster Making Competition. February featured blogs on World Zebra Day and other crucial environmental topics. Additionally, a **WWF Advocacy Workshop** was held on February 21st-22nd, focusing on environmental advocacy and engaging youth in these efforts.

March concluded the session with a blog on **World Wildlife Day**, celebrated on March 18th, which focused on biodiversity and wildlife protection. We also conducted a Stationery Donation Drive in collaboration with the Prayan Foundation on March 11th-12th, aimed at supporting underprivileged students.



In April, MH *Vatavaran* participated in the annual fest at Miranda House, "Tempest'23," by setting up an eco-stall. In continuing efforts to reduce the use of single-use plastics within the college campus, MH *Vatavaran* in collaboration with Bisleri's Bottles for Change CSR Initiative, worked towards creating a Zero Waste event. All types of used plastic waste – from plastic bottles and chips packets, were discarded in designated trash bins, collected and subsequently sent to Bisleri's recycling partners with the aim to ensure the proper recycling of these materials generated during the two-day event. The discarded plastic waste will be converted into flower pots, toys and plastic based garments. In addition, Bisleri displayed various recycled plastic products during two days of the college fest – highlighting the benefits of plastic recycling/upcycling. Volunteers of MH *Vatavaran*, faculty and students understood the importance of this noble cause of Plastic Waste Management, and participated with great enthusiasm. A series of environmentally focused events, starting with the "Planet vs Plastic" Seminar, where representatives from Greenpeace India discussed the severe environmental impacts of plastic pollution, including its effects on wildlife, human health, and the broader ecosystem, and advocated for a plastic-free future.







Additionally, on April 25th, we held a **Vertical Gardening Workshop in collaboration** with **Bisleri and MH** *Vatika*. This workshop provided participants with practical experience in creating vertical gardens, promoting sustainable living practices with expert guidance on the benefits and techniques of vertical gardening. The month also included a Photography Contest, an Online Quiz, and a Paper Presentation Competition, all designed to engage the community and raise awareness on various environmental issues.





In **May**, MH *Vatavaran* organized a heartfelt **Farewell Gathering** on May 13th, celebrating the contributions of outgoing seniors with gratitude and warm wishes. On May 19th, during the hostel's alumni gathering, they set up an Eco-Products Stall featuring items made from recycled paper, promoting sustainability while fostering connections among alumni.





