EOC conducted the freshers in the month of January due to the lag in the academic year by pandemic.50+ students joined the session which was held in google meet.




Equal Opportunity Cell Miranda House organised a talk on सा वि त्री बा ई फूले का सा हि त्य और वर्तमा न


