






On the 23rd of October,

Awards and recognition received

We are proud to announce that Celluloid has won the Filmmaking Fellowship Grant in November, 2021 and has been selected as one of the ten finalists for the documentary making competitions organised by The Hyphen. (Can you add a sentence on Hyphen)

We also won the Reel Making competition organized by Adwitya, The Fine Arts Society of Miranda House on the theme Animation.

Over the years, Celluloid has also been participating in various inter-college and university level competitions and has won accolades for the college. In the session 2019-2020, Celluloid secured the first position in Honest Trailer and third position in short film category at IIT Kanpur. At Udan Utsav, the society took away the second prize for Best Script and third prize for Best Direction in Documentary. In addition, Celluloid won the first position in the short film category at Jesus and Mary College, SGBT Khalsa and Sri Aurobindo College and first position again at IIT Bombay in One-minute filmmaking event.
