Society Activities

Society: Adwitiya-The Fine Arts Society

Year- 2017-18

Adwitiya, The Fine Arts Society organized and participated in several events like art sessions, workshops, competitions as summarized below:

Weekly Sessions, Outings, Calendar:

The society organized **weekly sessions** on quick art, theme based paintings, crafting, etc. aiming in personal development of each member of the society and introducing them to various art forms, painting techniques and methods. **Group tours** and live painting in various art museums and locations in Delhi were organized. A **calendar featuring the artworks of the members** was printed.

Workshops and Art Festival:

A a one day **Madhubani painting workshop by Mrs Seema Singh**, an artist in the field and founder of an organization 'Roots Tale' was organized on 25th September. The workshop was open to all the students in Miranda House and it aimed in teaching the Madhubani art form on paper, cloth and paper mache.

INNOSTAA:

A one week long Art Festival named 'INNOSTAA-2018' was organized from 15th to 20th January. A Live painting and fundraiser event was organized followed by workshops of nationally and internationally reckoned artists. From 16th to 17th January, the Madhubani Art workshop by Bharti Dayal was conducted. From 18th -19th January, Contemporary Art and Cartooning workshop by national award winning cartoonist Vikram Nayak was conducted. On the last day 20th January, an Acrylic Painting Workshop by Nawal Kishore was conducted. An exhibition displaying the artworks of the famous National Award winning Madhubani artist Bharti Dayal and the works of our members were displayed along the workshops in SAC. All the workshops were open to all students from Miranda and other colleges.



KUNSTENAAR:

Adwitiya hosted its **annual exhibition KUNSTENAAR** during Tempest'18. Tempest is that time of the year when everyone is enthused with festive mood. To add some colours in the festival, the society organized a three day event comprising of exhibition and competitions. Paintings and craft-work made by students throughout the year were showcased in the exhibition. Competitions such as Maidan-e-Craft, Treasure Hunt, etc. were conducted. MAIDAN-e-CRAFT was a crafting competition in which the students were provided basic materials to make an installation on the given theme 'Spirituality' in 1.5 hours. FUTURE OF FUN was an online digital poster making competition where students had to make the posters using virtual tools.

HUNT FOR ART was a treasure hunt event where students had to hunt for the cluesacross the college to paint their final artwork.

The exhibition received great response this year and was a fulfilling experience, both for participants as well as the society members.

Events and Competitions participated:

Adwitiya also participated in various competitions and exhibitions organised by various colleges around the country and won several laurels which are summarized as follows:

- A team of 8 students participated in the Fine Arts Competitions organised in Antaragni'17, the Annual Cultural Festival of IIT Kanpur which witnesses a high footfall from students across the country. Keeping up the previous records, the team performed exceptionally well, securing 1st and 2nd position in Naqaab(mask painting competition), 2nd position in Quilling competition and 3rd position in Dress Designing Competition. The opportunity provided the students a necessary exposure to competition and a worthwhile experience as a whole.
- A team of 4 students participated in the open art exhibition organised by Hindu College.
- Members of the society secured the 2nd position in the painting competition organised at DTU; 1st and 2nd position in the online art competition SANCHAYAN organised by Kak Enterprises; 1st position in Comic strip designing at Satyawati College; 2nd position in Quiling competition at SGTB Khalsa; 1st position in Poster Making competition by the Tricor Society, Miranda House; 2nd position in Rangoli Making competition by Botanical Society, Miranda House; 1st position in Rangoli Making competition by NSS, Miranda House.



The society also participated in the other competitions organized in Delhi College of Artsand Commerce, IGDTU, etc.
