



Events/Seminars/conferences/workshops/Extension Activities organized

- Paper writing competition "an eye for an eye makes the whole world blind "- (30 July 2020)
- Speaker session on Quit India day (8thAugust 2020)
- Poster making competition to indicate changing face of India was organized from10 August to 22nd August 2020.
- Creative writing competition under the title 'What does freedom mean to you?' was held by the Gandhi Study Circle from 10th August to 22ndAugust 2020.



- A dance competition was organized under the banner of 'our independence, our nation , our culture" from 10th August to 22ndAugust 2020.
- Launch of 'Adhyayan' blog was conducted on 14 September 2020. It provides an excellent opportunity to write blogs or short papers which are published on line. - Gandhian Week on 'Main bhi Gandhi' was organizedon26 September 2020 under which various competitions such as acting / dance / poetry competition along with cartoon making competition was conducted virtually. Most importantly presentation competitions were made on Mapping the ides of self-reliant village.
- Speaker session on "Relevance of judicial reform to make justice more accessible" was held on 26 September 2020.
- Gandhi Jayanti celebration was done on 2nd October 2020 in collaboration with ZHDC. During the even Sarangi performance, Meditation session and storytelling (*Dastane Bapu*) were conducted.
- Speaker session on 'Re-inventing Gandhi was also held on 2nd October 2020 and on 7th October an Emoji Quiz on Gandhi was conducted.
- On 30thJanuary 2021, Gandhi Study Circle observed Martyr's Day by organising an Inter-Faith prayer meeting wherein bhajans were recited and visually impaired students read teachings on peace from different Holy Scriptures. While observing the Martyr's Day and after offering homage to the father of nation, silence was maintained. A speaker's session was also conducted.
- Fresher's talent search competition was held on 8th February 2021 and Quiz competition on Mahatma Gandhi was held on 20 February 2021
