

Landscaping of the area under tree canopies has been carried out by planting beautiful luxuriantly growing perennials all around their bases. New *Ficus panda* hedge has been planted in the lawn beside the Principal's office. This year the malis also prepared splendid baskets of some herbs which are gracefully suspended from stands in the canteen lawn and are the cynosure of all eyes.
