### Year 2020-2021

During this academic year rock garden was developed on two mounds in the Technological park area of the college. A number of succulents, cacti, lava stones and pebbles were used to develop these two mounds. In the herbal garden carpet grass was laid on the soil. Several spices, such as *Cinnamomum camphora*, *Cinnamomum tamala*, *Cinnamomum verum*, *Curcuma longa*, *Elettaria cardamomum*, *Pimenta dioica*, *Piper nigrum* were planted that increased the total number of herbal plants to forty one in the herbal garden. For all the herbal plants name plates were made displaying their common name, botanical name and their uses. This information is very useful for students and other people who come to visit the herbal garden. The construction of boundary wall of herbal garden was also undertaken. The committee participated in the plantation drive 2020 activities of the Delhi University Garden Committee. We procured twenty-four saplings of nine different plants, namely *Aegle marmelos*, *Murraya paniculate*, *Saraca asoca*, *Jacrandra mimosifolia*, *Chorisia speciosa*, *Carissa carandas*, *Tabernaemontana divaricate* and *Ixora chinensis*. These saplings were planted in college and in non-teaching staff campus.

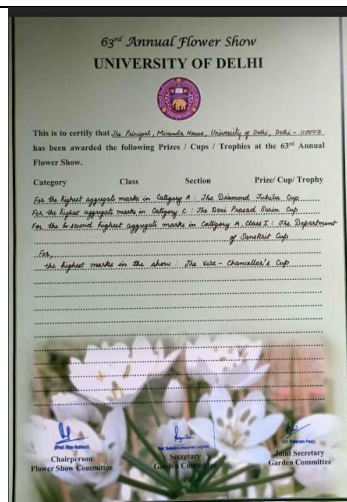
