During this academic year, we were engrossed most of the time in maintenance and taking care of our garden spaces, lawns and greeneries of the MH-Campus. Such green and colorful plants around the academic surroundings have always been inspired by the faculties, students and each member of Miranda House. This year we focused on planting more colorful annual plants. The garden distributed 100 plant saplings during the *#एक_पेड़_माँ_के_नाम* and *#Plant4Mother campaign*. The garden increased no. of beds and species (92) in the herbal garden. We also developed a new rockery near the old one and added new species to it. Now this time the no. of species reached 54 for both succulents and cactus. and the rock garden. The garden has developed one new rose bed near the hostel gate and developing a new one on the hostel lawn. Gargi College, University of Delhi under the Ashwagandha initiative, 191 saplings of Ashwagandha and other medicinal plants were distributed on 27 January 2025 by Garden committee. Our focus was to enhance campus biodiversity and plant more trees, shrubs and annual herbs. We also won the VC cup and many prizes in the 67th Annual Flower Show, University of Delhi. We have organized the college flower show (2nd HELLO Spring'25) on 4th March 2025 for the Miranda House family to showcase diversity in floral plants.


