The Indian Music Society of Miranda House, Geetanjali has participated in multiple competitions throughout the year.

- This year Geetanjali began their journey at the opening of the Independence Day celebrations on 13th of August 2016 in the college.
- Thereafter, they have performed at college functions like the Republic Day and the Alumni dinner celebrations.







- They also performed at the opening of the Sanskrit Shloka Competition conducted by the Sanskrit Academy and the alumni meet on 10 December 2016.
- Geetanjali participated in the first choir competition outside the college in AIIMS.
- Geetanjali students have participated in the cultural festival of IIT Kanpur and IIT Delhi organized in October 2016.
- This year the Geetanjali original composition in classical music choir competitions is a 'raagmalika', that is, a mixture of four ragas namely des, Megh Malhaar, Bhairavi and Madhuvanti set in Teental and Roopak taal. The concept of Raagmalika; Is used to convey different emotions ranging from the sheer joy, happiness and playfulness of the rainy season through Raag Des and Megh Malhaar and devotion and power to goddess Durga in raag Bhairavi, finally ending with

raag Madhuvanti which depicts the sringaar rasa or the different colours of love and eternity.
