The Indian Music Society of Miranda House, Geetanjali has taken part in multiple competitions in many prestigious platforms throughout the year of 2023-2024 including numerous events, seminars, conferences and workshops.

❖ Geetanjali began the session by holding two-round Auditions for the session 2023-24 to recruit new members into the society, receiving 200+ entries for the first round of auditions, which is the highest number of entries received in the history of Geetanjali and all the Indian Music Societies yet.



❖ After the second round of Auditions 2023-24 held on 14.09.2023, Six talented vocalists and Two talented instrumentalists were recruited into the society. As ECA entrants, Two vocalists and One instrumentalist were also recruited into the society. Geetanjali welcomed 11 new members into the society in the session 2023-24. 
