Events/Seminars/conferences/workshops/Extension Activities organized

National Cadet Corps, name of the organisation itself brings with it HIGH JOSH with unity and discipline. Miranda House NCC Company (MH NCC COY), began its session 2019-20 with lots of enthusiasm and energy which remained throughout the session.

In July 2019, 82 cadets were short listed and enrolled via a physical test and an interview, making a total strength of 160 cadets in MH NCC COY. Official classes were held on every Friday for four hours from 1 to 5 P.M. Classes were inspected by PI Staffs from Unit.

This year cadets have participated in many camps beginning with Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC) in Rohini Bhawan, New Delhi from 11th to 20th July 2019, in which 85 cadets of MH NCC participated and glorified the COY by becoming winner in group song competition and runner up in SW drill competition, Line Area, and Kabaddi. In the same month 5 cadets of MH NCC COY were selected for



Thal Sainik Camp and 3 of them made it to Final AITSC 2019 held in Delhi Cantonment from 16th to 27th September 2019. In September 2019, SUO Kiran was selected for Advanced Leadership Camp, Malout, and proved her leadership quality by becoming the camp senior. In the month of september, selections for the most prestigious camp of NCC, Republic Day Camp were held in which 6 students of MH NCC were selected (4 for drill and two for cultural) and CPL Arukshita Tyagi made it to Final RDC'2020 by being selected for Rajpath which brought immense pride to our college. From 4th to 15th November 2019, 10 cadets of MH NCC attended Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat Camp held in Rohini Bhawan, New Delhi. In the same month Cadets participated in Ajmer Trek and Sikkim Trek and gained lots of experience with adventure. In November, 3 cadets made it to the final PM Rally culturals. In January 2020, 2 cadets completed the Parasailing Adventure Camp held during PM Rally. The new comers of MH NCC also brought gratification to the COY as 6 of them got selected in CM Rally, January 2020. It is also worth of mentioning that CWO Komal Air Wing, went to Air Force Academy.

MH NCC COY has also organised a lot of events on different occasions with an aim of spreading awareness, creating inclusiveness and celebrating various special days. Events of this session began with March 2019 itself, following the occasion of World Water Day, on 30th March 2019, a "Water Awareness Rally" was conducted in which cadets wore their blue coloured NCC T-shirt, carried with them posters on water conservation and marched within the campus. On the occasion of International Yoga Day, a "Yoga Camp" was organised in the college premises from 12th to 21st June 2019, and from 18th to 21st June 2019, instructors were called and more than 50 people joined the camp (including NCC and Non NCC pupil). Following the International Day against "Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking", on 29th June 2019, a foot policing on the same was held in which students brought their placards and interacted to the workers and staffs of the college. The Independence Day was celebrated with high spirit by participating in the Flag hoisting Ceremony on 14th August 2019, and doing a ceremonial drill under Drill Commander SUO Kiran. MH NCC celebrated Gandhi Jayanti by giving importance to Gandhi Ji's dream of "Swachha Bharat" and successfully organised a "Swachhta Pakhwada" (Cleanliness Fortnight) from 17th September to 2nd October 2019. Various activities were carried out during these days including cleanliness drive, poster making and slogan writing on waste sheets, group discussions, recalling environment activists and their work, nukkad natak, watching relevant videos, poem recitation etc., covering various topics like Plastic Pollution and Sustainable Development. A collection drive of clothes, packed foods and stationery items was organised, with the objective of celebrating the 71st NCC day (to be observed on 24th November in 2019). 15 cadets went to Timarpur Basti, and distributed various collected items in that slum area. On 2nd January 2020, 15 cadets of MH NCC participated in the rally on "Pulse Polio Vaccination" conducted by 1DGBn under Mission Indradhanush. On 15th January 2020, cadets celebrated Army day in morning by organising and participating in poster making, slogan writing, and article writing competition. On 17th January 2020, MH NCC organised an amazing interactive session "AHWAAN" with Mrs. India'2017, Cpt. Shalini Singh about life's sophistication. The session was truly inspirational teaching all the cadets to stand strong and optimistic no matter how much ups and downs life shows. A platoon competition was observed on the occasion of Martyrs Day, 30th January 2020. On 4th February 2020, a Blood Donation Camp in collaboration with Indian Red Cross society was organised in which 70 people participated. On 14th, 17th and 18th February, a Civil Defence Workshop was organised by Directorate of Civil Defence in which 56 people participated. Miranda House NCC Company observed its Annual NCC Fest "Nischay'20" on 17th and 18th February 2020. The fest included various competitions (Debate, Quiz, Best Cadet, Rifle Run, Group Dance, Special Talent, Squad Drill and Quarter Guard). 23 colleges participated in it. The fest was



enriched by the presence of the Chief Guest Col. Pankaj Kumar Singh (Commanding Officer Of 1DGBn) and Guest of Honour Ms. Rachna Bisht Rawat (author of "The Brave, 1965").

MH NCC COY kept its legacy of actively participating in all camps and events and added glories to the COY by its various achievements. Availing all the opportunities to its full was only possible under the guidance and continuous support of Commanding Officer Col. Pankaj Kumar Singh, GCIs, Care Taker Officer Dr. Archana Kushwaha, Ex Associate NCC Officer Cpt. Dr. Ritu Ahlawat and Acting Principal Dr. Bijaylaxmi Nanda. MH NCC brought a thriving termination to its 2019-20 session with the involvement and talent of each and every cadet of the COY.
