ANNUAL REPORT 2022-2023

Carrying forward the rich legacy of ATEHNAS, the cadets of MH NCC COY have lived up to their name this year as well.

This session witnessed an array of additions to the long list of the company's achievements.

The Cadets of Miranda House secured 1st position in Kho-Kho and Squad Drill competition and 2nd position in Quarter Guard Competition. They also participated in Volleyball and cultural competitions organized during the Combined Annual Training Camp conducted from 7th June to 16th June 2022 at NCC Bhawan, Rohini.

CDT Vaishali Vishnoi participated in 50m Peep Sight Prone Event and qualified for AIGVMSC'22, where Inter Directorate Sports Shooting Championship was held from 4th July 2022 to 15th July 2022 in Chandigarh.
