### Events/Seminars/conferences/workshops/Extension Activities organized

NSS Miranda House organized the International Yoga Day on 21 June 2018, 50 NSS volunteers along with the members of National Cadet Cops organized a Yoga session in the college.

NSS orientation programme was held on 6 August 2018 in the college seminar hall which was attended by around 500 students. The convenor of the society, Dr. Nisha Nag of the Department of Hindi and Dr. Nisha Vashishta of the Department of Zoology, and the other staff advisors were present.

NSS Miranda House celebrated Swachhta Pakhwara from 1st of August 2018 to 15th of August 2018. Under



this we organized a cleanliness drive on 5th August 2018. Role of Cleaning in Disaster Management and during Disaster was an interactive session conducted under the DISASTER PREPAREDNESS TEAM of Miranda House on 14th of August 2018 from 2:00 pm to 3:30 pm in Student Activity Centre. We also had a Cleanliness Awareness Campaign in the Teaching Centre on 14th August 2018.
