Home visit to celebrate holi with our old friends. NSS, in collaboration with VISALAKSHI FOUNDATION organised a walk distributing food to the needy. August was marked by the the celebration of Independence Day through activities like Kalash Yatra, Har Ghar Tiranga, Nara Lekhan, Flag Hoisting and Pledge Taking, veero ka vandan as well as closing ceremony of Meri Mati Mera Desh Campaign held in Udyog Bhawan.

In September, NSS MH organised a week long NSS DAY celebrations with activities like blood donation campaign, CPR demonstration session, collection drive and elocution competition. October saw the celebration of Gandhi Jayanti with activities promoting Gandhian ideologies, as well as awareness events as cleanliness drives, kalash yatra, G20 cultural event.

In November, a week long Vigilance Awareness activities, Cartoon making and essay writing took place. January 2024 began with upcycling activities and the virtual celebration of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose's birth anniversary. Online webinar POCSO, republic day parade camp took place. February featured the Swachhta Pakhwada cleanliness programme, the Jeev Seva Campaign for feeding birds and stray animals, and the celebration of International Mother Language Day to promote linguistic and cultural diversity and participated in the National Adventure Camp held in Manali. December and January saw activities like **Nukkad Natak on Drug Awareness** and **Swachtha Pakhwada** activities included Awareness Drive I Plog Run I Cleanliness Drive in Hostel and Patel Chest a photography event for World Wildlife Day, **poster-making** for No Smoking Day, and celebrations of World Consumer Rights Day and the International Day of Happiness.

Indian Road Safety Campaign was initiated in which many activities like School Visit, On ground Traffic Regulation, Online sessions were conducted. Other significant events were Beti Bachao Beti Padhao and a Justice for Child Rights Campaign and participated in the **National Integration Camp** conducted in Karnataka. NSS MH also organised a **Pad distribution drive** in Azadpur Village.

Later activities include a series of **Stress awareness activities** which include Dance Workshop, canvas of wellness, Comforting Arms, Planting Peace, Doodle for Happiness Workshop, Meditation Session, Recreational Therapy, Creative Escape and Release and Reflect. NSS also organised **eminent women lecture series** under Women Led Viksit Bharat 2047. NSS organised RAAS the annual dandiya event of the college and had also set up a **Voter's Registration Desk**.

April and May featured various celebrations and activities for World Health Day, Earth Day, World Book Day, World Malaria Day, No Tobacco Day, World Athletics Day, International Menstrual Day, and Mother's Day, all conducted online. Offline activities included a 2-day **Mega Health Camp**.
