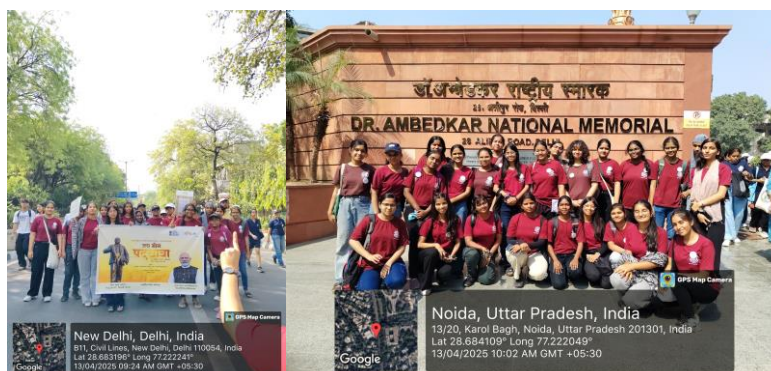

Name of the activity: Sunday on Cycles

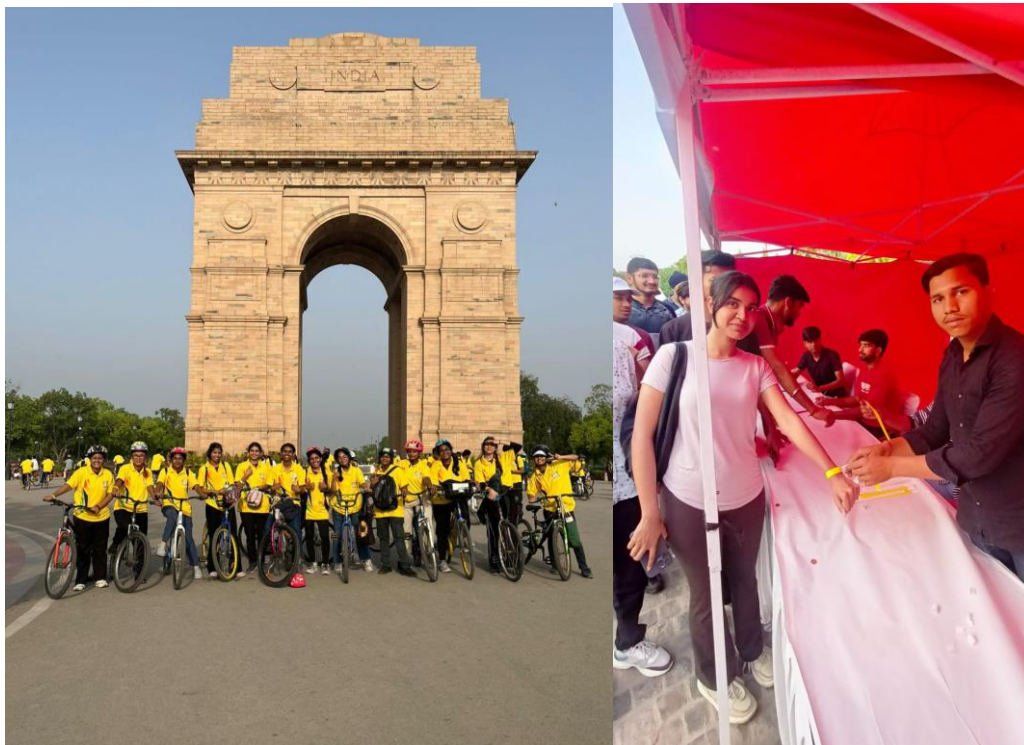

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Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam

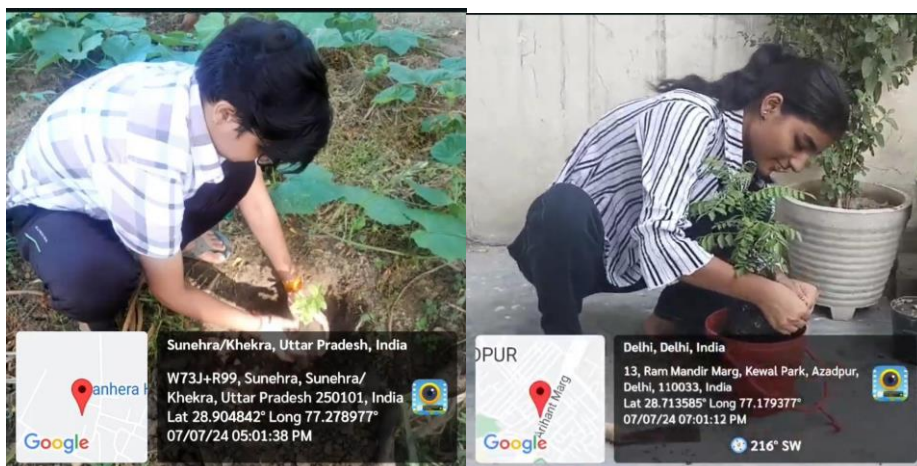
Name of activity: Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam

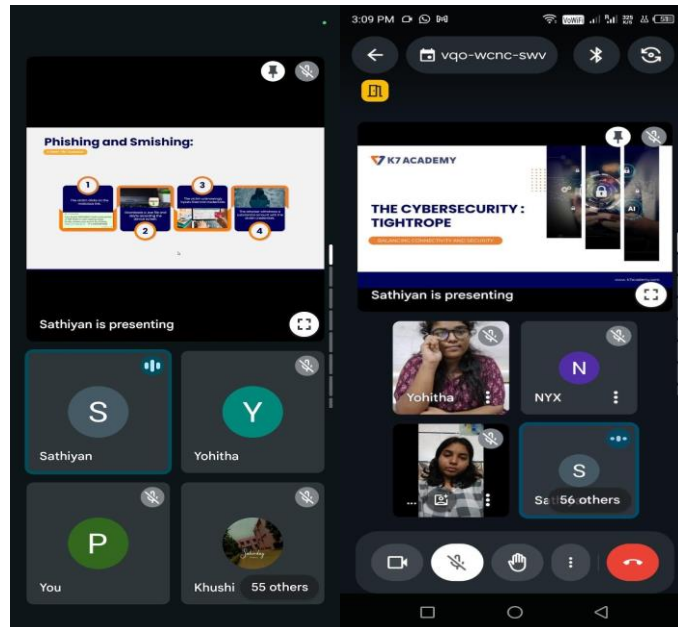
Cyber Security Session

Cleanliness Marathon

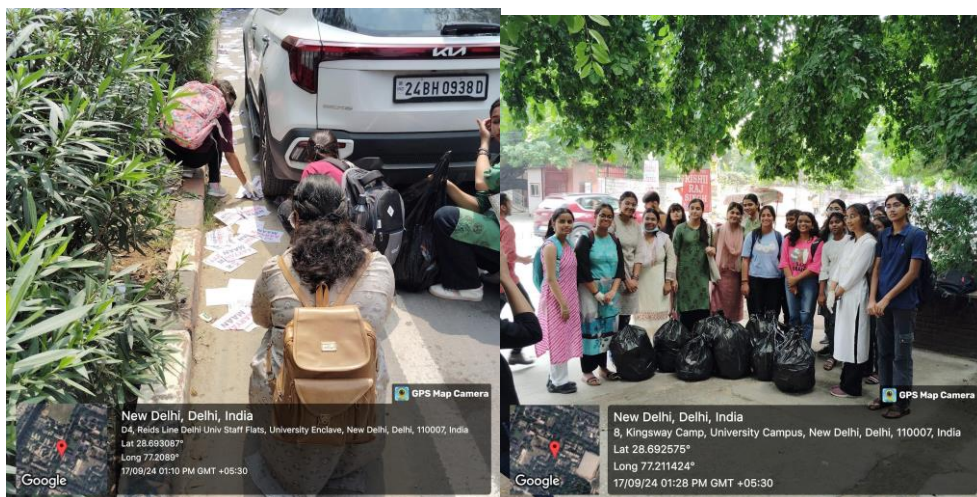

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Feeding Sparrows on World Sparrow Day

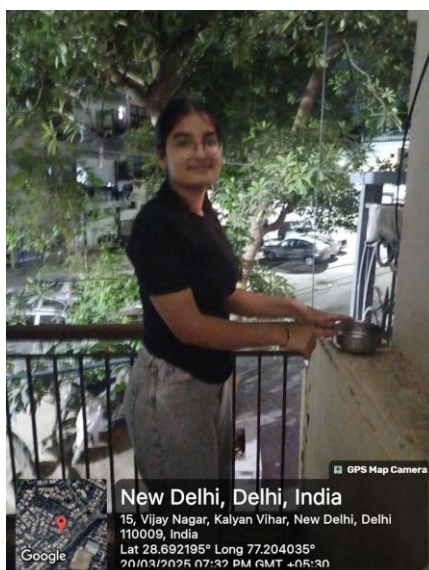

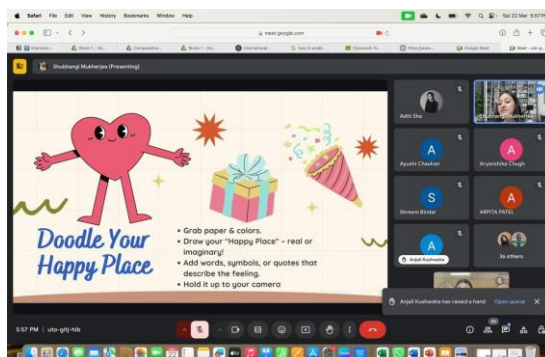

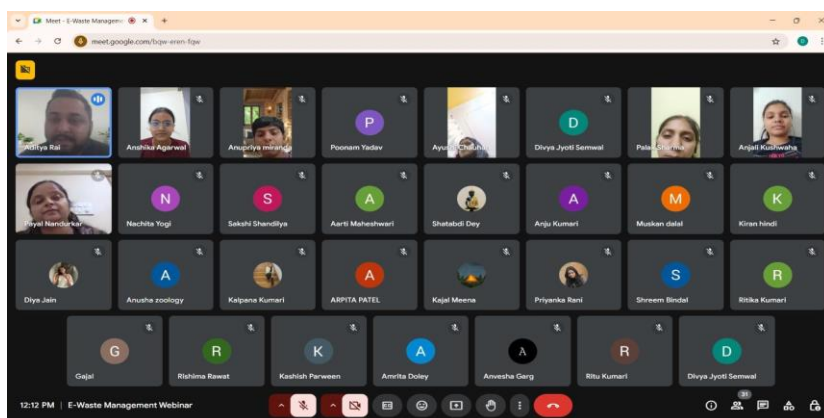

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utilized as a form of biological control. This innovative approach highlights the effectiveness of using nature-based solutions to manage mosquito populations and mitigate the spread of dengue.

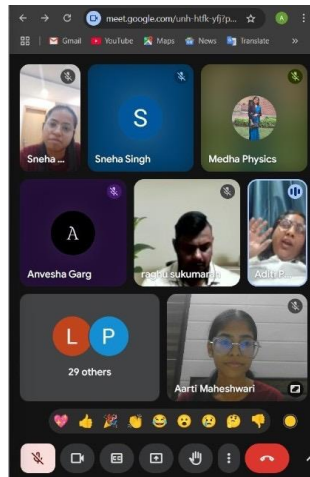

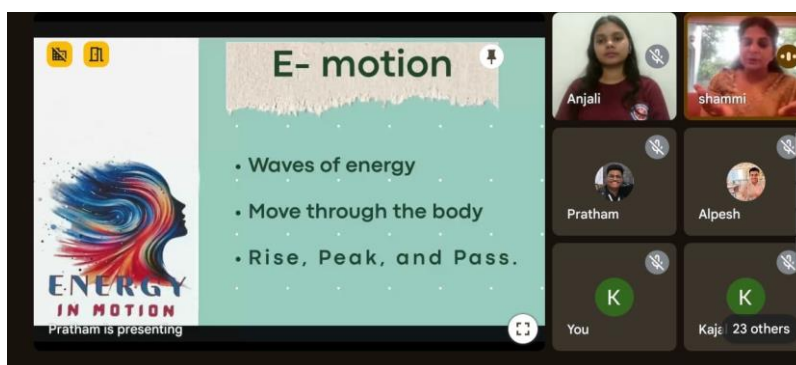

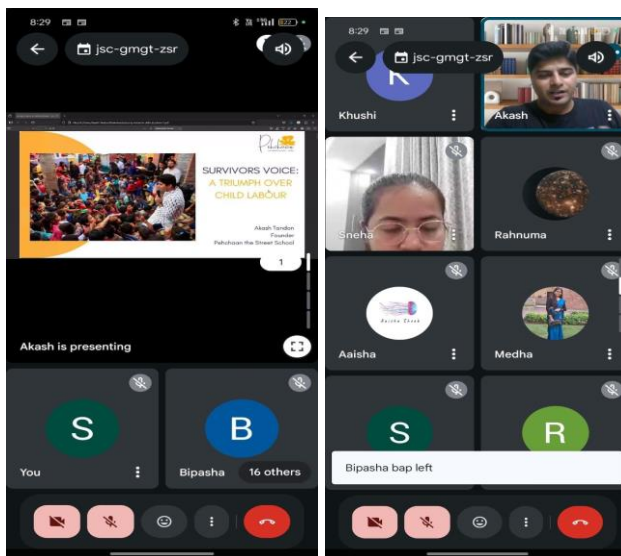
