

QUIZ SOCIETY ANNUAL REPORT 2021-22

The Quiz Society of Miranda House has had an enriching session with multiple sessions, quizzes and workshops throughout the year, helping the members inculcate within themselves a healthy attitude for garnering knowledge from all aspects of lived reality and much more.

The society started the year by conducting Legal Quiz on the theme "Rethinking Women's Empowerment and Gender Equality" in collaboration with Pink Legal Panache along with Legal Debate and Quiz Committee (Faculty of Law, University of Lucknow) on 25th July 2021, which saw the participation of over 70 individuals from all over the nation.

The society also collaborated with over a dozen quizzing societies across Delhi University and Viraasat Knowledge LLP and held two fundraiser quizzes : India Quiz and General Quiz on 11th and 12th July 2022 respectively. The proceeds of the fundraiser were donated to The Sheroes Hangout Cafe, Noida - a cafe run by acid attack survivors.

On 9th August 2021, the society organized a 'Quizzing and Question Making Session' hosted by Miranda House Alumni Twinkle Gupta, to acquaint the society members with the frills and thrills of collegiate quizzing. The session was extremely helpful, interactive and replete with- fundas, do's and don'ts in quizzing and a discussion on the promotion of sensitive and conscious behavior in the circuit.

Following this, the society conducted a series of 5 recruitment quizzes in the first week of September 2021 for the second and third years of the college via Google forms and 5 students made the cut to become a part of the society.

On 19th October 2021, the Quiz Society collaborated with Arthashastra, the Economics Department of Miranda House and conducted an intra-college Economics and Business quiz titled Equizzity. The quiz was only open to students of Miranda House and saw a participation of over 50+ students.

On the 25th of November 2021, the society held an Orientation Session for the freshers batch of '24, where the students were familiarized with the idea of collegiate quizzing and the work they'll be expected to do as members of the society.

This was followed by another series of 5 Recruitment Quizzes in January 2022 where 17 new enthusiastic and inquisitive members were inducted into the society. After this, the society organized "What to set when you are setting" - A quizzing workshop by ex-president and ace quizzer Pragati Nautiyal on 30th January 2022 to further guide the society members in the art and craft of making and conducting quizzes.

In addition to this, throughout the year the members held intra-college sessions online and offline where members as well as non-members took part with an aim to have a better experience of quizzing. Furthermore, short Whatsapp quiz sessions (~10 questions) were conducted thrice a week wherein a member prepared questions on any topic of their choice and all other members worked to answer them.

Due to Covid-restrictions during the end of the session, the society was unable to conduct its flagship festival - The Annual Rachita Dasgupta Memorial Quiz Fest.

The events of the year, conducted in a hybrid mode by student members of Quiz Society, provided a stimulating and good learning experience to all members of the society. Many members of the society have contributed to various fundraising quizzes throughout the year in an individual capacity as well.

Lastly, the members of the society have had an extremely fruitful year in terms of performance at quizzing events conducted by other colleges and institutions all over the country in both the online and offline mode. The members bagged more than 30+ podium finishes with prizes and top positions which upheld the prominent position of Quiz Society Miranda House in the prestigious Delhi Quizzing Circuit throughout the quizzing season.
