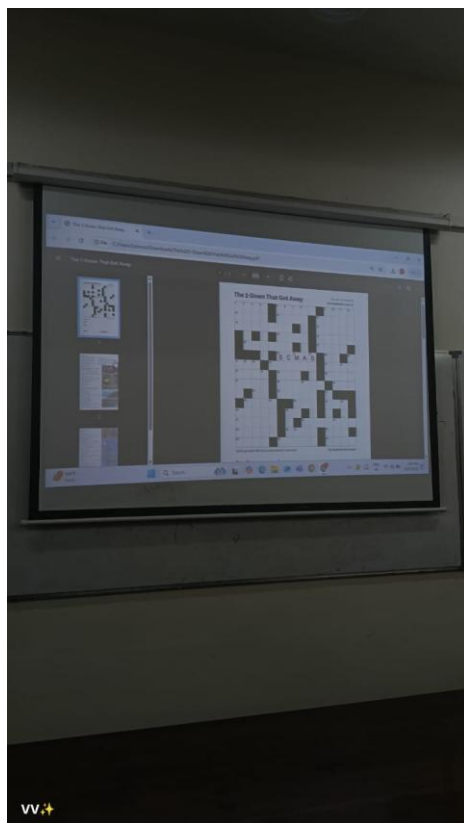

Time: 1:00 PM onwards

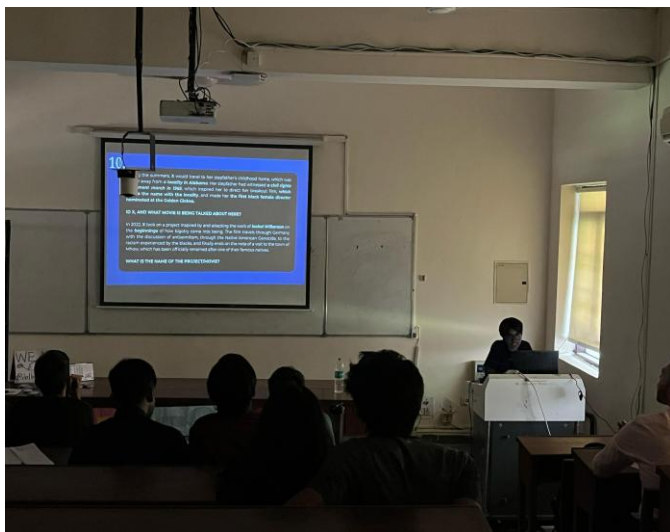
Eligibility: Under 23 | Team Size: 1–2 members
