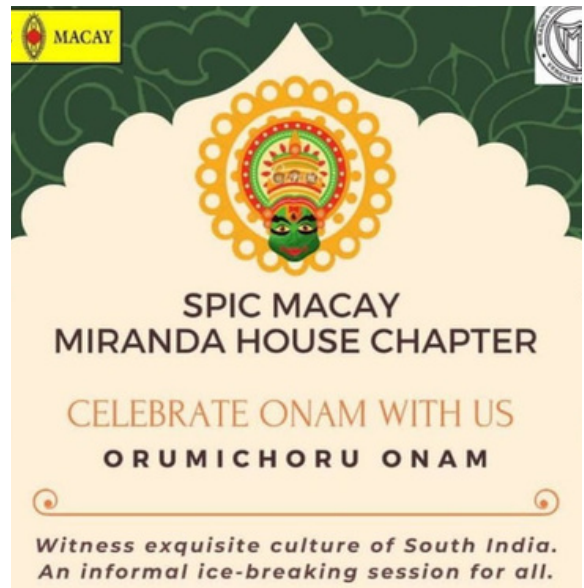

Celebrating Harvest festivals of India


16 JANUARY 2021

24 FEBRUARY 2021

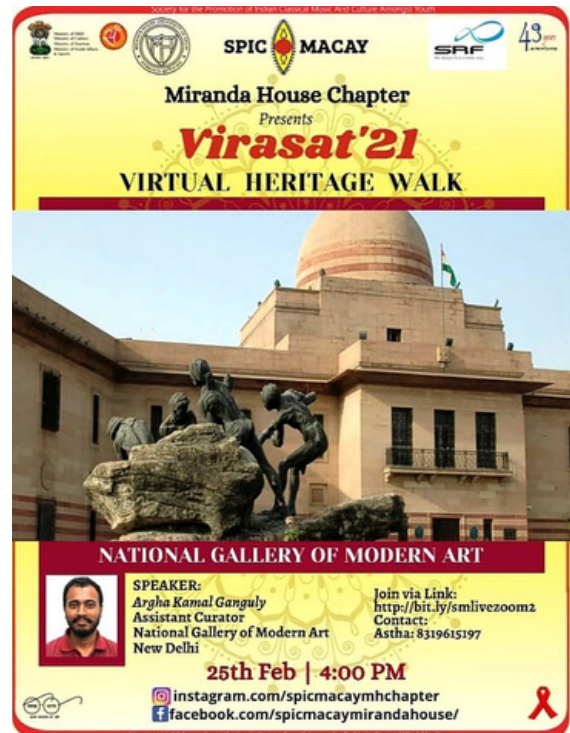

Virtual Heritage Walk: Virasat

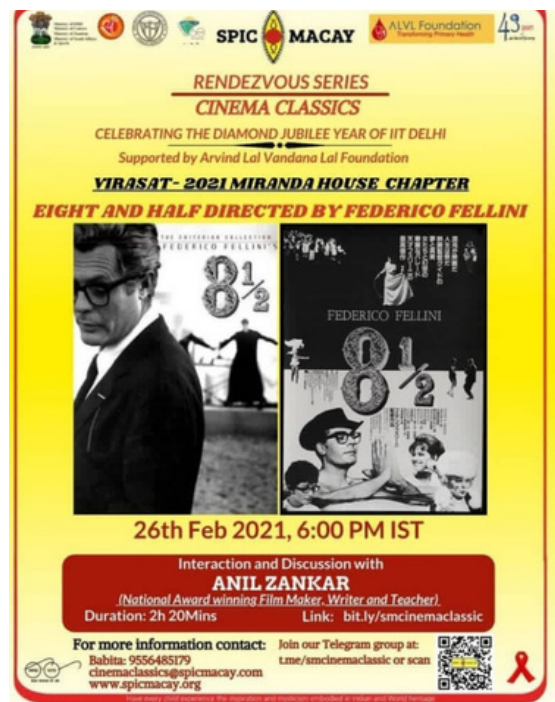
25 FEBRUARY 2021

Classical Music Program: Virasat

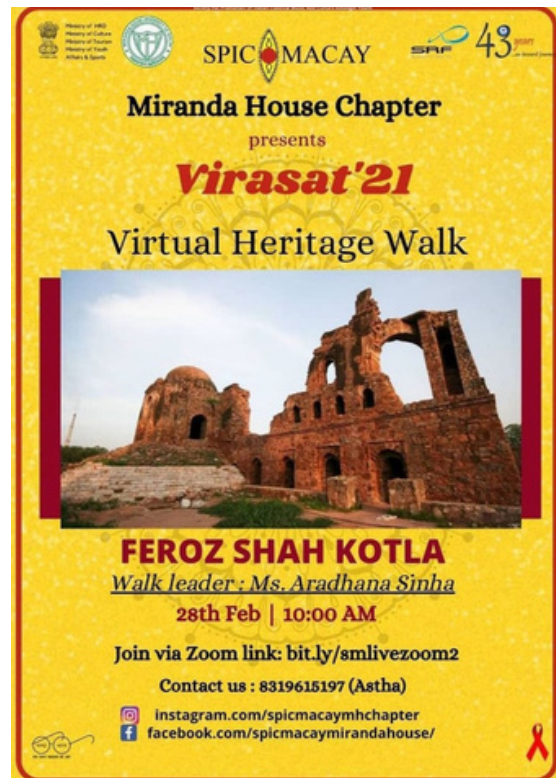


27 FEBRUARY 2021
