# Talk Session- The Art of Photo-making: An Introduction to Alternative Photography

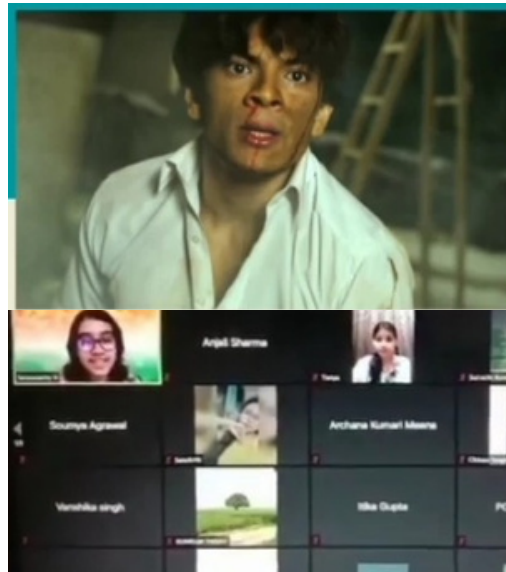
7 August 2021

# **Virasat 2022- Heritage Walk to Humayun's Tomb**

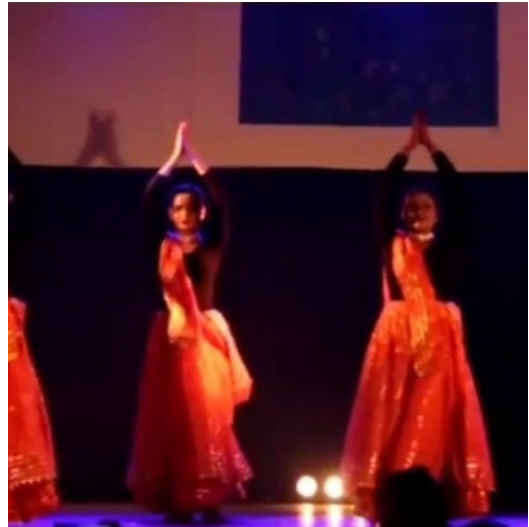


12 March 2022
