#### **TULA ANNUAL REPORT 2017-18**

TULA, Miranda House Consumer Club has been playing a pioneering role in developing consumer awareness. Academic Session of 2017-18 marked an important year carrying forward this movement through various activities. On April 21, 2017, the Department of Political Science and TULA- Miranda House Consumer Club organized an interactive session with students in collaboration with TERI University on "Consumer Behaviour and Sustainability". The event commenced with the official release of *SANTULAN*, the annual magazine of TULA- the Miranda House Consumer Club. This was followed by the keynote address of the guest of honor, Fawzia Tarannum, Lecturer, Department of Regional Water Studies, TERI University. Fawzia Tarannum engaged in a thought-provoking discussion with the students regarding sustainable development, the water crisis and proper water management in India. The students were also shown a rather informative movie clip on Sustainable Water Management Practices which had been made by students at TERI University.

After the induction of new students into the society, Freshers' Talent Search was organised on 18th August. For the Tula's Miss Fresher, the competition was competitive as numerous students registered. The competition was organised under three different activities - 1. Poster Making 2. Creative Writing 3. Slogan Making. The theme of the talent search was "Is Consumer really the king in the market?" Soumya Mathur was selected as Ms. Fresher of TULA, Miranda House Consumer Club.

TULA, Miranda House Consumer Club in collaboration with the Department of Political Science,



organized a day-long event, 'Corruption Free India starts with me' on 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2017 as a part of vigilance awareness week. The event saw large participation from the students through the activities such as Flash Mob, Quiz competition, Elocution Competition. The chief Guest, Ms. Sonali Singh, Additional Secretary, CVC, GOI, addressed the students on the issue of corruption and institution's role in tackling the problem. Highlight of the event was 'Integrity Pledge' administered by the principal where students vowed together to eradicate corruption.

TULA organised its 12th successive three-day Annual Workshop on Consumer Awareness with various interactive sessions which drew participation from a number of students and faculty on 23-25 January 2018. In one of the sessions, Ms. Pushpa Girimaji, Consumer Rights Activist enlightened the students about civil society's need of vigilance and accountability of service providers. Ms. Pragya Singh Baghel and Ms. Astha Tyagi, advocates on Record Supreme Court of India gave an insight about the ground realities of service delivery and consumer rights. This was accompanied by a presentation on Intellectual Property Rights by Ms. Nishi Shabana (principal associate at Singhania and Partners LLP). On the concluding day, Mr. Ciby James and Mr. Amit Chatterjee from ASQ Ltd. unraveled the relation between cost and quality of a product. In the final session, *What have we learnt?* students made individual and group presentations in various creative ways. Prizes and certification of participation were given away to the winners of competitive events and participants of workshop.

Members of TULA participated in a Nukkad Natak Competition conducted by IT department, Government of India under the campaign of 'Clean Money for New India'. The play which was based on the theme of income tax evasion qualified in the top 8 contestants.

On the occasion of World Consumer Rights Day, 15th March, TULA members led an initiative in which consumer awareness slogans, important facts were pasted over 150 coffee cups across the college. The initiative was highly appreciated by students and faculty.




