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Guidelines:

- This competition is open to students of all departments in Miranda House.
- Participants can come in teams of maximum 2 students.
- Participants are required to make 5-7 minute, short, topic-specific educational videos (English/Hindi/Bi-lingual, they have to be easy to understand) based on NCERT Class
 6-8 syllabus (any subject- you can find the syllabus here: <u>https://bit.ly/3ia91ps</u> and NCERT books here: <u>https://bit.ly/3x8pDCt</u>)
- Each video will cover one specific topic from a given chapter, based on the NCERT book syllabus.
- Participants are required to express the subject they are interested in making a video on. The specific topic within that subject shall be provided by MH, UBA Cell organising team (to avoid inter-team repetition).
- In addition to the video, participants are requested to provide a short worksheet related to the given topic, and links to other related YouTube resources.
- All participants will be provided a certificate from Miranda House, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Cell.
- First 3 winners will be awarded exciting prizes.

Stage I:

Interested participants have to fill the given Google Form, mentioning the names and contact details of team members and the subject in which they are interested in making a video. Here is the link to the <u>Google Form</u>.

This form will remain open for 1 week (form open till: 11.59 pm, Monday, August 9, 2021) Here is the <u>link to an excerpt from a sample video</u>.

Stage II:

A meeting will be held where all interested participants will be assigned topics randomly, and will be briefed about the tools, templates and resources that can be used to make the videos efficiently and easily. This will also be a learning opportunity for participants. The participants can make any suggestions and ask any questions and doubts in this session.

After this, all teams will get 1 week to submit the videos, worksheets and resource list for evaluation (videos will be accepted till: 11.59 pm, Monday, August 16, 2021).
