Background: The Indo-Dutch Collaborative Program has been a unique exchange initiative between Miranda House, Sri Ram College of Commerce and Utrecht Business School, Hogeschool Utrecht University of Applied Sciences, Utrecht, since 2008. The primary purpose of this program is to provide our students with an opportunity for an international, inter-cultural interaction on an academic platform. The course is inter-disciplinary, with a mix of lectures from academics as well as industry experts. This series of programs has by now become a prototype for successful collaboration across colleges within Delhi University and with a foreign institution.
