CIRCULAR

Subject: Santosh Bhutani Memorial Award for the year 2022-23

Santosh Bhutani Memorial Award was instituted by Ms. Damyanti Bhutani, sister of late Ms. Santosh Bhutani who was a member of the administrative staff of the College from 1950-92. There are six awards for wards of non-teaching staff.

- (i) Two students of Semester II, one each from Social Sciences and Humanities, and Science Group on the basis of Class XII marks (BoF/PCM/PCB) and University Examination Semester I. If there is no student in either Humanities and Social Sciences or Sciences, the entire amount will go to the only candidate available in Humanities and Social Sciences or Sciences as the case may be.
- (ii) Two students of Semester IV, one each from Social Sciences and Humanities, and Science Group on the basis of cumulative marks in University Examinations Semester I to Semester III. If there is no student in either Humanities and Social Sciences or Sciences, the entire amount will go to the only candidate available in Science or Humanities as the case may be.
- (iii) Two students of Semester VI, one each from Social Sciences and Humanities, and Science Group on the basis of cumulative marks in University Examinations Semester I to Semester V. If there is no student in either Humanities and Social Sciences or Sciences, the entire amount will go to the only candidate available in Humanities and Social Sciences or Sciences as the case may be.

In case of failure in any of the examination the fellowship may be discontinued.

The award is in the nature of a fellowship of at least Rs.1000 depending on the number of applicants.

The staff whose wards are studying in Miranda House may apply for the same along with the last examination marksheet latest by **22.03.2024 (Friday)**.
