



- 3. Time Limit: The total duration of the competition will be 45 minutes. No extra time will be provided.
- 4. Participants must bring their own pencil, eraser, and colored pencils if
- 5. Sheets will be provided at the venue.
- 6. Drawings must include:
 - Detailed and accurate botanical sketch of the specimen as observed
 - Labeled plant parts
 - Name of the Family
 - Key characteristic (diagnostic) features
- 7. The sketch must be an original representation of the provided specimen. Any attempt to copy from external sources will lead to disqualification.
- 8. Winners will be announced in valedictory session, and certificates/prizes will be awarded.
