Internal Academic Audit Observations & Suggestions

Academic Year: 2020-21 (from 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2021)

Observations:

1. The faculty embraced to new pedagogical styles to make the transition from offline to online teaching process. Many teachers enrolled and completed faculty development course for enhancing IT skills for multifaceted teaching.
2. E-resource repository were created in form of recorded lectures, online resources and collaborative lecture series were organized at national and international level.
3. Faculty with extensive knowledge networks were leveraged for student internships in work from home mode. These internships gave them monetary support and kept them mentally engaged. Financial assistance to students in need.
4. Peer group mentoring system was made robust. Mental health workshop was organised to ensure mental wellbeing of the students as well as faculties.
5. “Beyond classrooms” activities were organized by creating platform like *samwad* for peer mentoring and group discussion.

Suggestions:

1. Need to strengthen internal departmental mechanisms to maintain student placement data and student progression.
2. The Department can strengthen UG research by offering students summer workshops/ projects.
