The Scholarships are:

- Kali Charan Puri Doctoral Scholarship – 3 (Rs 50000 x 3)
- Kali Charan Puri Graduate Scholarship – 6 (Rs 25000 x 6)

Lodha Foundation Scholarships and Fellowships

These scholarships and fellowships were founded by Lodha Foundation, Mumbai for promoting research and scholarly work in the fields of 'Rural Development' and 'Public Policy'.

The Fellowships are:

- Lodha Foundation Senior Fellowship – 1 (Rs 150000 x 1)
- Lodha Foundation Research Fellowship – 2 (Rs 100000 x 2)

The Scholarships are:

- Lodha Foundation Doctoral Scholarship – 3 (Rs 50000 x 3)
- Lodha Foundation Graduate Scholarship – 8 (Rs 25000 x 8)

The above Scholarships and Fellowships are for research work for a duration ranging from three months to one year. Last date for sending applications is December 31, 2019.

Interested students, researchers and scholars can apply for these academic assistance programmes. Selection will be done on the basis of academic potential and relevance of the topic proposed and competence of the candidate for the desired research work.
